



Coronavirus / Covid-19 Agreement

I acknowledge the contagious nature of Coronavirus and that the latest government guidance recommends practising social distancing and a range of other protective measures.

I recognise that Rialize Childcare Ltd has put in place a series of protective measures to reduce the risk of Coronavirus transmission within the setting, but I accept that Rialize Childcare Ltd cannot guarantee that my child will not be exposed to Coronavirus whilst attending the club.

I understand that I must follow the procedures set out by Rialize Childcare Ltd when dropping off and collecting my child from the setting. See overleaf.

I understand the importance of vigilance regarding Coronavirus symptoms as a keystone of preventing the transmission of the virus to other children, staff and parents. Accordingly, I confirm that:

- My child is not experiencing any Coronavirus symptoms such as cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fever, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or new loss of taste or smell.
- My child has not tested positive for Coronavirus, or been advised by NHS Test & Trace to self-isolate.
- My child has not been in contact with anyone in our household who has Coronavirus symptoms, or who has been advised by NHS Test & Trace to self-isolate.
- My child has not travelled abroad to any country other than those identified as 'safe' by the government within the last 14 days.
- My child has an understanding of the club rules relating to protective measures, such as not mixing with children in other bubbles, washing their hands regularly, coughing and sneezing into a tissue and disposing of it safely, and staying at a distance from others.

If any of the above circumstances change, I will not bring my child in to the club and will notify the club staff immediately.

Coronavirus / Covid-19 Agreement

The health and safety of your children and our staff is paramount. Our core values are to provide a consistent and reliable service for parents and a club where children have the power to choose their own fun. We welcome children back for the autumn term 2020 with new operating procedures in place. We will operate differently.

Gov guidance on health and safety measures required on Early Years Settings: *“Childcare practitioners do not need PPE. They should care for children as normal, although increasing the frequency of handwashing.”*

Children will not be required to wear face coverings and it is not recommended for early years children. Older children can choose to wear face coverings if they wish or if it is parental preference.

Staff will be provided with PPE including face masks, gloves and aprons if they choose to wear it. This will not be mandatory.

Gov guidance on Health and Safety measures required in Early Years Settings: We know that, unlike older children and adults, early years and primary age children cannot be expected to remain 2 metres apart from each other and staff. In deciding to bring more children back to early years and schools, we are taking this into account. Schools should therefore work through the hierarchy of measures set out:

- Avoiding contact with anyone with symptoms
- Frequent hand cleaning and good respiratory hygiene practices
- Regular cleaning of settings
- Minimising contact and mixing

Families must maintain a 2m distance from others whilst waiting for club to open

Only one parent to drop off or collect the child from the club where possible

Parents cannot enter the building and staff will sign children in and out on the registers

Children will be organised into fixed areas or ‘bubbles’. Children will be taken to wash their hands frequently throughout the day and immediately upon arrival at the club, before and after eating. Hand sanitiser and tissues are available in every room and at the club entrances.

Limiting the number of children who use the toilet facilities at one time. Toilets and frequently used surfaces will be cleaned throughout sessions

All equipment cleaned after use and thorough cleaning done every day. Soft furnishings, soft toys, toys that are difficult to clean and other unnecessary items will be removed from spaces.

If a child develops any symptoms of Covid-19 during a session, then they need to be isolated and their parents/carers informed so that they can come and collect them as quickly as possible. Managers will identify a space where the child can be isolated safely and supervised.

The member of staff supervising the child will wear PPE and the area will be deep cleaned once the child has been collected.

- Children will be organised into their 'bubbles' and remain in them for every session attended
- Activities will take place outdoors as much as possible
- Staff will talk to and remind children about new measures
- Handwashing at regular points throughout the session
- Set rotas to ensure regular anti-bac cleaning of high frequency areas, furniture and equipment
- Regulate number of children using toilets

Staff will have received training to ensure they are confident in the new regime. We take the health and safety of your children and our staff extremely seriously

The stringent measures we have put in place for our club, along with the training of staff, and communication for parents makes Rialize a Covid-19 secure operator.
